AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW PROVIDING PENSIONS FOR CERTAIN WIDOWS OF POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS KILLED IN LINE OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 100 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word, "person" in line 5, the
3 following words:—or as a result of an accident involving a
4 police department vehicle which he is operating or in which
5 he is riding in the performance of his duty as a police
6 officer.
