AN ACT AMENDING THE PROFESSIONAL CORPORATION LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 156A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 8, as appearing in chapter 654 of the acts
3 of 1963, and inserting in place thereof the following:—

4 8. No person shall be a shareholder of a professional cor-
5 poration unless he is duly registered to render the same pro-
6 fessional services as those for which the corporation was or-
7 ganized. At least one director of a professional corporation
8 shall be duly registered to render the same professional serv-
9 ices as those for which the corporation was organized. Any
10 officer of a professional corporation must be duly registered
11 to render the same professional services as those for which
12 the corporation was organized, except the clerk, who may be
13 so registered.
