AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RIGHTS OF CERTAIN SCHOOL PERSONNEL EMPLOYED BY REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 42B of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 653 of the acts of 1969, is further
3 amended by adding the following new paragraph:—

4 Any employee subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-
5 one of the General Laws, employed by a local school committee
6 of a town in the district whose position is superseded by rea-
7 son of the establishment and operation of a regional school
8 district shall be employed by the regional district school com-
9 mittee without loss of any civil service or other rights pre-
10 viously acquired by his employment.
