AN ACT REQUIRING THE TEACHING OF CONSUMER EDUCATION IN
PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting in the fourth sentence, as most recently amended the
3 chapter 187 of the acts of 1966, after the word "arithmetic,"
4 the words:—modern economics.

It is the sense of the House that the Department of Justice should be authorized to conduct a comprehensive review of the activities of the Federal Bureau of Investigation in the area of racial discrimination.
