AN ACT TO PERMIT CITIES AND TOWNS TO USE CHAPTER NINETY FUNDS FOR STREET LIGHTING ON SO CALLED CHAPTER NINETY ROADS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection 2 (a) of section 34 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence
3 thereof and substituting the following:—(a) For expenditure,
4 under the direction of said department, for maintaining, re-
5 pairing, improving and constructing town and county high-
6 ways, including proper street lighting, together with any
7 money which any town or county may appropriate for said
8 purposes to be used on the same highways.
