### AN ACT TO PROHIBIT STANDEES IN SCHOOL BUSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 7B of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended,  
2 is hereby further amended by striking out clause (2) as  
3 presently appearing therein and substituting therefor the  
4 following:—

5 (2) Each school bus shall contain adequate seating accom-  
6 modations for each passenger transported therein, and no  
7 school child shall be allowed to stand in any school bus while  
8 such bus is in motion.
