AN ACT TO INCREASE THE REVENUES OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY
TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Whereas, the Massachusetts Port Authority, through
- 2 Logan International Airport, uses the transit facilities of the
- 3 Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority as much as does a city
- 4 or town, therefore,
- 5 The Massachusetts Port Authority shall pay the Massa-
- 6 chusetts Bay Transit Authority an amount of money equal to
- 7 the amount of the deficit attributable to the number of
- 8 passenger and work trips originating anywhere within Logan
- 9 International Airport. This amount shall be calculated by
- 10 using the formula used by the Massachusetts Bay Transit
- 11 Authority for express services.
