
By Mr. Smith of Lawrence, petition of Lawrence P. Smith relative to the application of the civil service law for employees holding tenure who are transferred to a school district which is not subject to said law. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPLICATION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW TO EMPLOYEES WHO HOLD TENURE UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW WHO ARE TRANSFERRED TO A SCHOOL DISTRICT WHICH IS NOT SUBJECT TO SAID LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 47A of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as most re-
2 cently amended by chapter 74 of the acts of 1967, is hereby
3 amended by adding the following paragraph:—

4 Whenever a school district is established by general or special
5 law to which the provisions of this chapter do not apply and
6 said district is to include a school or schools of a city, town or
7 school district to which, prior to said establishment the pro-
8 visions of this chapter were applicable, any employee in such a
9 school shall, if he so requests, be transferred to the newly es-
10 tablished school district. Any employee so transferred shall
11 retain his civil service rights under sections forty-three and
12 forty-five and his rights to transfer held by him immediately
13 prior to such transfer, provided that such rights shall apply only
14 while he is serving in the same capacity or position held on the
15 effective date of the transfer to the school district which is not
16 subject to the provisions of this chapter. Nothing in this para-
17 graph shall prevent the reassignment of the employee to another
18 school which is to continue in a school system subject to the
19 provisions of this chapter or to prevent a transfer, if such as-
20 signment or transfer can be made in lieu of a transfer to the
21 newly established school district.

The Commission of Investigation

Section 1. The Commission of Investigation shall consist of the following members:

1. The Governor, who shall be the Chairman of the Commission.

2. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.

3. The Speaker of the House of Representatives.

4. The Chief of the Executive Department.

5. The Chief of the Legislative Department.

6. The Chief of the Judiciary Department.

7. The Chief of the Executive Department.
