AN ACT TO FACILITATE MAINTENANCE OF MASSACHUSETTS PORT
AUTHORITY PROPERTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 The Massachusetts Port Authority is to assume responsibil-
2 ity for the removal of all debris that clings to cyclone fences
3 on Massachusetts Port Authority land.

The Constitution of the State

Article I. The Legislature

Section 1. The legislative power shall be vested in the Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The Senate shall be composed of members elected by the electors of the State.

Section 3. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members elected by the electors of the State.

Section 4. The members of the Legislature shall be elected for a term of two years.
