*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Clause Third of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 500 of the acts
3 of 1957, is hereby further amended by inserting after para-
4 graph (b) the following paragraph:—

5 (b½) Real estate occupied or used for boarding or lodging
6 the students of literary and educational institutions shall not
7 be exempt; and.
