## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT TO APPOINT SUPERVISORS OF SPECIAL CLASSES FOR MENTALLY RETARDED CHILDREN IN ALL CITIES AND TOWNS OF AT LEAST TWENTY THOUSAND INHABITANTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:*

- 1 Section 46 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 3 Every city and town in the commonwealth having a school
- 4 population of twenty thousand or over shall appoint a super-
- 5 visor of all special classes for mentally retarded children
- 6 in that city or town. Said supervisor to have had experience in
- 7 teaching in such special classes, or to be certified as qualified
- 8 by the department of special classes for mentally retarded
- 9 children in the department of education.
