*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-

- 3 *Section 14E.* If a regional school district accepts pupils
- 4 who reside in a town other than a member town of the district
- 5 the amount of tuition to be charged the town of residence of
- 6 such pupils shall be fixed by the regional district school com-
- 7 mittee.
