By Mr. Peck of Dartmouth, petition of Raymond S. Peck relative to requiring the posting of warning signs on any way in which radar equipment is in use for the purpose of detecting the violation of certain motor vehicle laws. Public Safety.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE POSTING OF WARNING SIGNS ON ANY WAY IN WHICH RADAR EQUIPMENT IS IN USE FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETECTING THE VIOLATION OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 17 the following section: —

3 *Section 17A.* There shall be posted on every way in the
4 vicinity of which radar equipment is used for the purpose of
5 detecting the violation of any motor vehicle law for which a
6 penalty may be imposed, adequate signs in appropriate places
7 warning the operators of motor vehicles that such equipment
8 is in use.
