AN ACT PERMITTING COMPENSATION BE PAID TO CERTAIN MEMBERS OF LOCAL RETIREMENT BOARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (c) of subdivision 4 of section 20 of chapter 32
2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
3 last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
4 sentence:—Nothing in this paragraph shall prevent any city
5 auditor, town accountant or other officer having similar
6 powers and duties, or any other person who serves in the
7 active administration of the system in lieu of the city auditor,
8 town accountant or other officer having similar powers and
9 duties, or an elected employee representative, from being
10 compensated for services rendered in the active administra-
11 tion of the system; provided that the compensation for such
12 services shall be not less than two hundred nor more than five
13 hundred dollars per annum and shall be payable from the
14 expense fund of the system.
