AN ACT REGULATING MEMBERSHIP OF SCHOOL COMMITTEES IN CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 52 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 90 of the acts of 1932, is hereby
3 further amended by adding at the end thereof the fol-
4 lowing paragraph:—

5 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law to
6 the contrary, no member of any school committee in a city
7 except the mayor shall, during the term for which he was
8 elected, hold any other office or position the salary or
9 compensation for which is payable out of the city treasury.
