AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF STUDED TIRES ON PUBLIC
HIGHWAYS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of section seven of chapter
2 ninety of the General Laws notwithstanding, no vehicle
3 equipped with studded tires shall be operated on any public
4 highways between May first and October first of each year.

1 SECTION 2. Violations of the provisions of this act shall be
2 punishable by a fine of twenty dollars for each offense.
