Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the General
- 2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 190
- 3 of the acts of 1961, is hereby further amended by inserting
- 4 after paragraph (d) the following paragraph:—
- 5 (e) Any member attaining twenty-five years or more of
- 6 creditable service who is fifty-five years of age or over will be
- 7 eligible to retire under the same basic retirement allowance
- 8 formula used to compute the retirement allowance of a Group
- 9 4 member of corresponding age with the same years of
- 10 service.
