**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENT OF A PENSION TO A WIDOW UPON THE DEATH OF A RETIRED MEMBER OF A POLICE DEPARTMENT OF A CITY OR TOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, in the  
2 event of the death of a person retired from the police depart-  
3 ment of a city or town, the amount of the pension he was  
4 receiving at the time of his death shall continue to be paid  
5 to his widow until her death or remarriage.
