AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING OPTIONS ON RETIREMENT UNDER THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Option (c) of subdivision (2) of section 12 of chapter 32 of
- 2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 713
- 3 of the acts of 1960, is hereby further amended by adding the
- 4 following two paragraphs:—
- 5 If a member who has elected option (a) dies within a year
- 6 of the date of his retirement, leaving a widow, such widow
- 7 shall receive the retirement allowance she would have re-
- 8 ceived if the member had elected this option.
- 9 If the wife of a member who has elected this option dies
- 10 within a year of the date of the member's retirement such
- 11 member shall thereafter receive the retirement allowance he
- 12 would have received if he had elected option (a).
