AN ACT PROVIDING A CERTAIN REAL ESTATE EXEMPTION FOR THE YEAR IN WHICH A PERSON REACHES HIS SEVENTIETH BIRTHDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 419 of the acts of
3 1966, is hereby further amended by adding the following
4 sentence:—Any person otherwise eligible for the exemption
5 under this clause shall, in the year in which he reaches his
6 seventieth birthday, be entitled to a partial exemption of
7 such amount, which shall be in the same proportion to the
8 full exemption he would have been entitled if he had passed
9 his seventieth birthday before the first day of January in such
10 year as the total number of months that he was seventy years
11 of age bears to the twelve month period.
