

HOUSE No. 3440

By Mr. Flaherty of Boston, petition of Michael F. Flaherty for the apportionment of costs of county government between the cities of Boston, Chelsea and Revere and the town of Winthrop. Counties.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE CITIES OF CHELSEA AND REVERE AND THE TOWN OF WINTHROP TO PAY THEIR PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE EXPENSES OF SUFFOLK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Annually before May first, the director of
2 accounts provided for by section one of chapter fourteen of
3 the General Laws shall determine the amount expended by
4 the city of Boston for county purposes in the preceding year,
5 shall allocate said amount among the cities of Boston,
6 Chelsea and Revere and the town of Winthrop in proportion
7 to their populations as determined by the latest census, state
8 or national, next prior to such allocation, and shall certify to
9 the treasurer of said cities and towns such determination and
10 allocation. On or before November twentieth in each year,
11 there shall be paid to the city of Boston by the cities of
12 Chelsea and Revere and the town of Winthrop the amount of
13 such expenditures respectively allocated to them in such
14 year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first,
2 nineteen hundred and seventy.
