AN ACT RELATIVE TO GROUP INSURANCE FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law,
2 the division of employment security is hereby authorized and
3 directed to contract for group hospitalization insurance for
4 the following groups of employees:

5 (a) employees receiving unemployment compensation who
6 are not entitled to any other insurance benefits from private
7 contracts;

8 (b) employees engaged in a lawful labor dispute who are
9 not entitled to any other insurance benefits from private
10 contracts; and

11 (c) employees who have become unemployed due to sick-
12 ness and who are not entitled to any insurance benefits from
13 private contracts.

1 SECTION 2. The cost of said insurance policies shall be
2 borne one half by the employee and one half by the common-
3 wealth.
