AN ACT ABOLISHING THE RATE SETTING POWERS OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE RELATIVE TO COMPULSORY MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the con-
2 trary, the commissioner of insurance shall not set the rates for
3 insurance under the compulsory motor vehicle insurance
4 laws. The power to set Massachusetts compulsory insurance
5 rates shall be vested in the general court.
