

HOUSE No. 3629

By Mr. Menton of Watertown, petition of Paul C. Menton that dealers in second hand motor vehicles be required to furnish in writing an express warranty of merchantability. Commerce and Labor.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT SALES BY DEALERS OR RETAILERS OF USED CARS SHALL CONTAIN AN EXPRESS WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 57 of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 32 of the acts of 1968, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following paragraph:—

4 All sales of second hand motor vehicles made by any
5 person required to be licensed by this section shall be in
6 writing and shall contain an express warranty on the part of
7 such licensee that such motor vehicle is fit for the purpose for
8 which it was intended.
