AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EDUCATION OF CHILDREN AFFLICTED WITH MULTIPLE HANDICAPS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 29E, the following section:—
- 3 *Section 29F.* The department is hereby authorized upon
- 4 the request of the parent or guardian of any child who,
- 5 because of multiple handicaps, is unable to participate in a
- 6 public school educational program, to provide for the instruc-
- 7 tion for such child in a special school, hospital, sanatorium or
- 8 like institution.
