AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LOWER PREMIUM CHARGES ON MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE OF OWNERS WHO TOTALLY ABSTAIN FROM THE USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special  
2 law to the contrary, the commissioner of insurance shall es-  
3 tablish a lower premium charge on motor vehicle liability  
4 insurance policies of owners of motor vehicles who totally  
5 abstain from the use of alcoholic beverages.
