AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO RECONSTRUCT A RAILROAD BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF SWAMPSCOTT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to reconstruct the existing railroad
3 bridge located at Essex street in the town of Swampscott.

1 SECTION 2. For said purposes said department may expend
2 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

By the House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Conference with the Senate, approved August 1, 1908.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I. Section 1.

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 3. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for a Term of six Years; and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Senators of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 4. The Times, Places and Manner of holding the Elections of Senators and Representatives, shall be prescribed in each State by the Legislature thereof; but the Congress may at any time by Law alter or change in any or all of those Things the Time, Places and Manner of holding such Elections, provided they do not alter or change the same with respect to the
