AN ACT CONCERNING TIDEGATES AND THE LIKE IN THE METROPOLITAN SEWERAGE DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 92 of the General Laws, as amended, is
2 hereby further amended by adding at the end the following
3 paragraph: —

4 The commission shall maintain, keep in good repair and,
5 when necessary, reconstruct all apparatus in the metropolitan
6 sewage district controlling the flow from sewers and drains into
7 rivers, tidal waters and other waterways of every description
8 and from rivers, tidal waters and such waterways into sewers
9 and drains.
