AN ACT REGULATING THE WEIGHING OF PREPACKAGED MEAT, POULTRY AND EDIBLE FISH SHELL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 56B of chapter 98 of the General Laws, inserted by
2 chapter 19 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended by adding
3 at the end the following paragraph:—

4 For the purpose of this section, prepackaged meat, poultry
5 or edible fish shall not include processed products normally
6 known as delicatessen cuts or cold cuts, nor any canned meat,
7 poultry or fish.
