AN ACT INCREASING THE FEE FOR A LICENSE TO OPERATE CERTAIN CAMPS, CABINS, MOTELS OR MOBILE HOME PARKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 32B of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 4 of chapter 592 of the acts of
3 1964, is hereby further amended by striking out the second
4 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:
5 —The fee for each original or renewal license shall be ten
6 dollars.
