*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Chapter 70 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 7 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 8.* In addition to the amounts provided for in this
- 4 chapter the commonwealth shall provide an additional pay-
- 5 ment of ten per cent to all community schools so-called.
