AN ACT PROVIDING THAT TOWNS MAY CONTRACT FOR THE RENTAL OR
LEASE OF TEMPORARY SCHOOL ACCOMMODATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 4 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 24 of chapter 849 of the acts of
3 1969, is hereby further amended by adding at the end the
4 following paragraph:—

5 For the rental or lease of temporary school accommoda-
6 tions. Contracts for such accommodations may be made for
7 periods not exceeding three years.
