### AN ACT INCREASING THE PUNISHMENT FOR THE USE OR POSSESSION OF MOLOTOV COCKTAILS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 102B of chapter 266 of the General Laws, inserted  
2 by chapter 431 of the acts of 1969, is hereby amended by strik-  
3 ing out, in lines 6 and 7, the words "two and one-half years,  
4 or both", and inserting in place thereof the following words:—  
5 five years nor less than two and one-half years, or both.

THE SEVERAL ARTICLES.

2. by chapter 411 of the acts of 1890, is hereby amended by strike-
3. ing out in lines 8 and 7 the words "two and one-half years,"
4. and inserting in place thereof the words "two years—
5. two years not less than two and one-half years, or half."
