AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 547 of the acts of 1969 is hereby amended by
- 2 adding after section 2B the following section:—
- 3 *Section 2C.* Employees of welfare departments of cities and
- 4 towns who transferred to the state department of public
- 5 welfare and are now state employees shall have their salaries
- 6 increased as prescribed for in this act.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMMISSION OF CONNECTICUT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, in addition:

1. Chapter 247 of the acts of 1900 is hereby amended by adding after section 27 the following sections:—
2. Section 27. The Governor and his assistants shall have the honor and authority to the said department of public affairs and the new state university shall have the honor and authority as provided in this act.
