AN ACT REQUIRING THE BUREAU OF BUILDING CONSTRUCTION TO APPOINT A CLERK OF THE WORKS FOR EACH CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT FOR WHICH THE CONSTRUCTION IS PLANNED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 53 of chapter 704 of the acts of 1969 is hereby
2 amended by adding the following sentence:—The bureau of
3 building construction shall appoint a clerk of the works for
4 each project subject to the approval of the head of the
5 department for which the construction is planned.

It is the duty of the Commission to make a study of the conditions of the laboring classes in the city of New York, and to report thereon to the Board of Education, and to the Board of Health, and to the Board of Charities, and to the Board of Social Welfare, and to the Board of the City of New York, and to the Board of the State of New York, and to the Board of the United States of America, and to the Board of the World.

Section 23 of chapter 100 of the laws of the City of New York, passed July 1, 1911, is amended by adding the following sentence:—The Bureau of Building Construction shall appoint a clerk of the works for each project subject to the approval of the head of the department for which the construction is planned.
