*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, all  
2 real and personal property of public authorities may be taxed  
3 by the cities and towns of the commonwealth in the same  
4 manner and to the same extent as any private corporation.
