AN ACT RELATIVE TO MANDATORY LEGISLATION AFFECTING CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of law, the state treasurer
- 2 shall annually reimburse cities and towns for all amounts of
- 3 money expended by them in complying with the provisions of
- 4 mandatory legislation which takes effect on or after January
- 5 first, nineteen hundred and seventy.
