AN Act relative to the FIXING OF SALARIES OF MEMBERS OF THE
SCHOOL COMMITTEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 52 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 52A.* Notwithstanding the provisions of section
- 4 fifty-two, in any city or town which accepts the provisions of
- 5 this section, the annual salary of members of the school
- 6 committee shall be fixed by the city council in the case of a
- 7 city and by the board of selectmen in the case of a town.
