AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE BY A TOWN OF ANY INSURANCE PROCEEDS FOR A CASUALTY LOSS OF SCHOOL PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 53B the following section:—

3 *Section 53C.* Whenever in any year a town shall receive
4 any proceeds of insurance for any casualty loss of school
5 property, such proceeds shall be deposited with the treasurer
6 of such town and held as a separate account and may be
7 expended by the school committee without further appropria-
8 tion to repair or replace the casualty loss for which insurance
9 proceeds have been paid.
