## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

### AN ACT FURTHER CLARIFYING CANCELLATION OF AUTOMOBILE FINANCIAL INSURANCE PREMIUMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 21 of chapter 255C of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the last two sentences, added by chap-  
3 ter 133 of the acts of 1966, and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following sentence:— If a premium finance agency, or any  
5 holder of a premium finance agreement, acting under a power  
6 of attorney in connection with the cancellation of a motor vehicle  
7 liability policy, as defined in section thirty-four A of chapter  
8 ninety, gives notice of cancellation in accordance with section  
9 thirty-four K of said chapter ninety, and the insured pays the  
10 full amount then due under the premium finance agreement not  
11 less than three days prior to the effective date of cancellation,  
12 such agency or holder shall forthwith notify the insurer in writ-  
13 ing that it is revoking the notice of cancellation.
