

HOUSE No. 4417

By Mr. Tagman of Worcester, petition of Charles T. Tagman relative to authorizing certain motor vehicle liability insurance policies to be extended by endorsement. Insurance.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY POLICIES TO BE EXTENDED BY ENDORSEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of special or general law to the
2 contrary, all motor vehicle liability insurance policies written on
3 January first, nineteen hundred and seventy for those registrants
4 holding registrations expiring after January first, nineteen
5 hundred and seventy-one but before January first, nineteen
6 hundred and seventy-two shall be extended by endorsement
7 to expire on the last day of the month that the registration
8 expires. Subsequent policies shall be written for an annual
9 period from the last day of the month of the expiring registration
10 to the last day of the month of the new registration. New
11 policies shall be written up to a thirteen month period from the
12 date of the newly issued registration to the last day of the
13 month that the new registration expires.
