By Mr. Feeney of Boston, petition of Walter D. Nolen that the city of Boston be authorized to convey a certain portion of Franklin Park, adjacent to the Lemuel Shattuck Hospital in said city, to the Department of Public Health. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Required.]

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO CONVEY A CERTAIN PORTION OF FRANKLIN PARK, ADJACENT TO THE LEMUEL SHATTUCK HOSPITAL IN SAID CITY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The city of Boston, acting by and through its parks and
- 2 recreation commission, is hereby authorized to convey to the
- 3 department of public health a certain portion of Franklin
- 4 park in said city consisting of approximately 1.9 acres in area
- 5 being bounded and described as follows:—
- 6 South Westerly by Norton Street, 206.77 feet; North
- 7 Westerly by Cemetery Road, 212±; North Easterly by
- 8 Forest Hills Entrance Drive, 436± feet; South Easterly by
- 9 Lemuel Shattuck Hospital, 298.06 feet, adjacent to the
- 10 Lemuel Shattuck Hospital, bounded by Jewish War Veterans
- 11 Highway, Morton Street and the present grounds.
- 12 Upon such conveyance, said department is hereby autho-
- 13 rized to construct and thereafter operate and maintain
- 14 therein such facilities as it deems essential to its maintenance
- 15 and operation of said hospital.
