

By Mr. Herman of Worcester (by request), petition of Francis J. Flynn and another that certain civilian operators of the Worcester fire alarm division in the city of Worcester shall become eligible for membership in the fire department of said city. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Required.]

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN CIVILIAN OPERATORS OF THE WORCESTER FIRE ALARM DIVISION IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER SHALL BECOME MEMBERS OF THE WORCESTER FIRE DEPARTMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Upon the effective date of this act, the follow-  
2 ing personnel of the Worcester Fire Alarm Division, namely,  
3 Francis X. Horgan, Bernard F. O'Brien, Norman H. Dupuis,  
4 Francis J. Flynn, William P. Sarsfield, Jeremiah C. Lynch,  
5 shall become members of the Worcester firefighting force,  
6 subject to a qualifying examination by the division of civil  
7 service, and shall have the same sick leave, vacation,  
8 seniority, promotion, employment and pension rights as any  
9 employee of the city of Worcester, and shall be subject to  
10 transfer and assignment to any duties within the Worcester  
11 fire department as the chief engineer of the said department  
12 may determine, but shall retain their classification, insofar as  
13 practicable under the civil service laws and rules relating to  
14 classification, and rate of pay received by them as members of  
15 the Worcester Fire Alarm Division.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
