### AN ACT PROVIDING A LIEN TO A GARAGE OWNER ON ABANDONED JUNK CARS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any  
2 garage owner who has been in possession of an abandoned  
3 junk automobile, where no owner is available, may with the  
4 authorization from the registry of motor vehicles dispose of  
5 said vehicles as payment for the towing and storage charges.
