By Mr. Cronin of Andover, petition of Paul W. Cronin for legislation to provide additional compensation for police officers for certain educational accreditation. Public Service.

AN ACT PROVIDING ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 108L the following section:—
3 *Section 108M.* Any permanent member of a police depart-
4 ment who has earned a minimum of sixteen semester hours
5 credit in law enforcement or a related field from an accredited
6 college or university shall be paid an additional salary at the
7 rate of five dollars per semester hour of credit with an annual
8 maximum of five hundred dollars upon receipt of an associate
9 degree in law enforcement. Any such member of a police de-
10 partment who continues his education in law enforcement
11 beyond an associate degree shall be paid an additional salary
12 at the rate of eight dollars per semester hour of credit with
13 an annual maximum of one thousand dollars upon receipt of
14 a bachelor's degree in law enforcement. Such permanent mem-
15 bers of police department who have earned both an associate
16 degree and bachelor's degree in law enforcement shall be
17 limited to an annual maximum of one thousand dollars in-
18 crease in salary.
