AN ACT ESTABLISHING A BUREAU OF METROPOLITAN PROJECTS
WITHIN THE DIVISION OF CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION OF THE
STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 Section 1F of chapter 15 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 3 There shall be established in the division of curriculum and
- 4 instruction a bureau to be known as the bureau of metropolitan
- 5 projects. The said bureau shall propose projects and programs
- 6 which may be implemented by any group of cities or towns
- 7 acting in concert. In proposing such programs and projects, the
- 8 bureau shall act in an advisory capacity only and the actual
- 9 implementation thereof shall be undertaken by cities and
- 10 towns involved.
