RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE RATES CHARGED BY UTILITY COMPANIES FOR POWER.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-
3 tives, five persons to be appointed by the governor, the depart-
4 ment of public utilities commissioner or his designee, and three
5 representatives of the various power companies, is hereby
6 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study
7 of the rates charged by utility companies for power with particu-
8 lar reference to demand charges.
