AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF EXEMPTION ALLOWED TO OWNERS OF ESTATES OF HOMESTEAD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 188 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in section 1 of chapter 32 of the acts of 1939, is hereby
3 amended by striking out, in line 3, the word "four" and
4 inserting in place thereof the word:—ten.
