## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE OVERPASS OVER MT. PLEASANT STREET IN THE CITY OF NEW BEDFORD AS THE JOHN PHILLIP REYNOLDS OVERPASS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The overpass over Mt. Pleasant street in the  
2 city of New Bedford shall be known and designated as the  
3 John Phillip Reynolds overpass, in memory of John Phillip  
4 Reynolds, who was killed in action while a member of the  
5 armed forces of the United States in World War I. Suitable  
6 markers bearing said designation shall be attached thereto by  
7 the department of public works in compliance with the  
8 standards of said department and as authorized by the  
9 Federal Bureau of Roads.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter seventy-two of the acts of nineteen  
2 hundred and sixty-nine is hereby repealed.
