AN ACT TO DIRECT THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC WELFARE TO EXERCISE GREATER CONTROL ON THE DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN AID.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The commissioner of public welfare is hereby directed to
2 promulgate rules and regulations which will provide the depart-
3 ment of public welfare with greater control over the distribution
4 of food, furniture and clothing on voucher requests.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

ARTICLE I

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

Section 3. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for six Years; and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Senators of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
